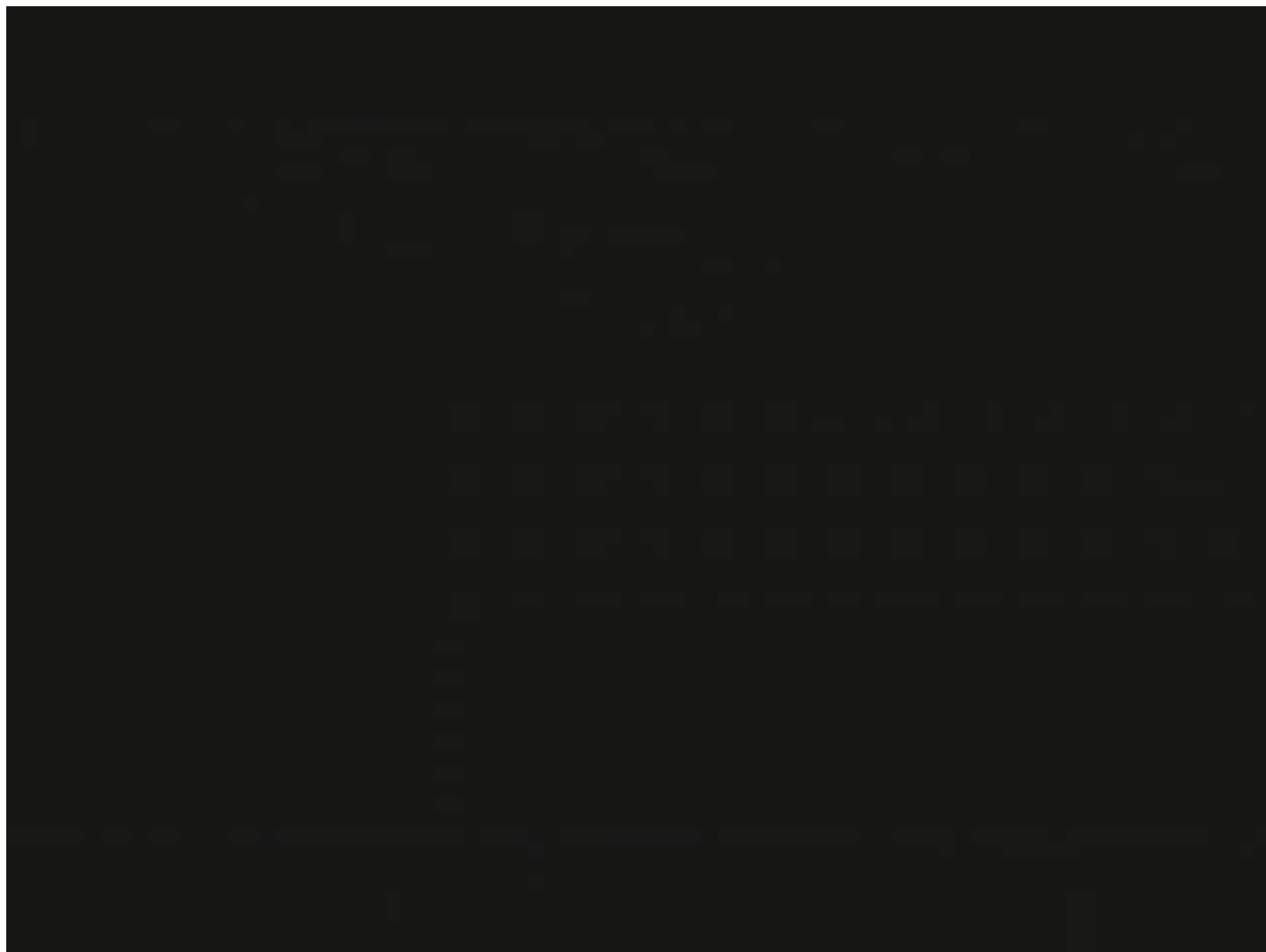

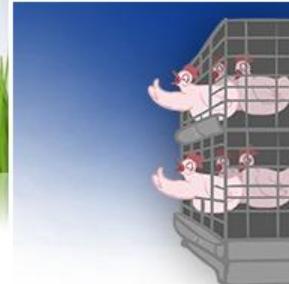

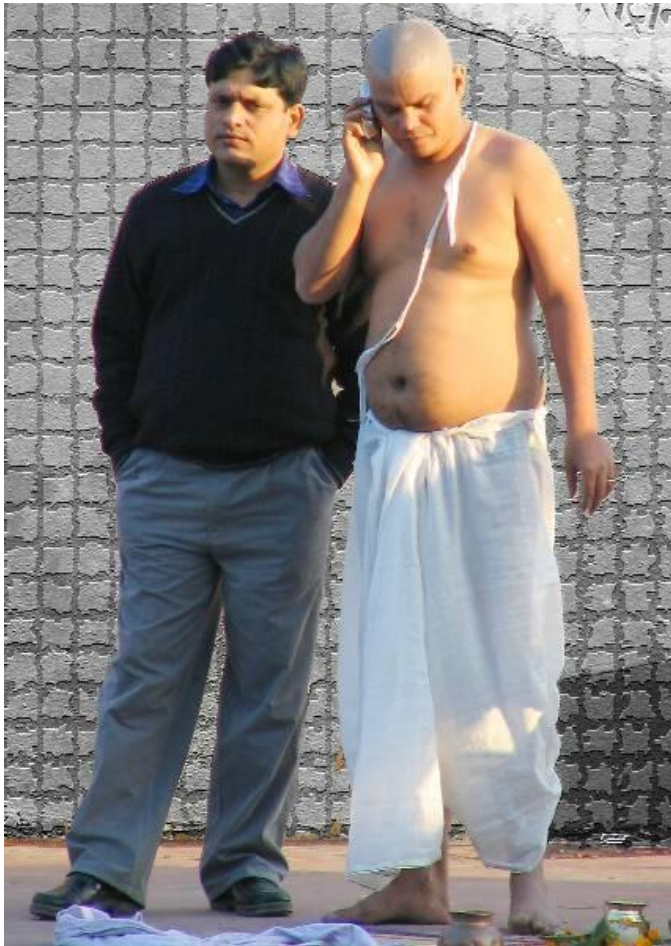

No Brasil, bilhões de galinhas, porcos, e outros animais de produção sofrem maus-tratos rotineiros em granjas industriais superlotadas, estressantes, e insalubres. Muitos passam a maior parte da vida confinados em gaiolas ou celas. No Brasil, dezenas de milhões de galinhas poedeiras passam suas vidas alojadas em "gaiolas em bateria" (filas de gaiolas de arame dispostas uma por cima das outras) e mais de um milhão e meio de porcas gestantes sofrem em celas que medem nada mais do que 60 cm de largura.

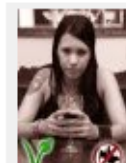

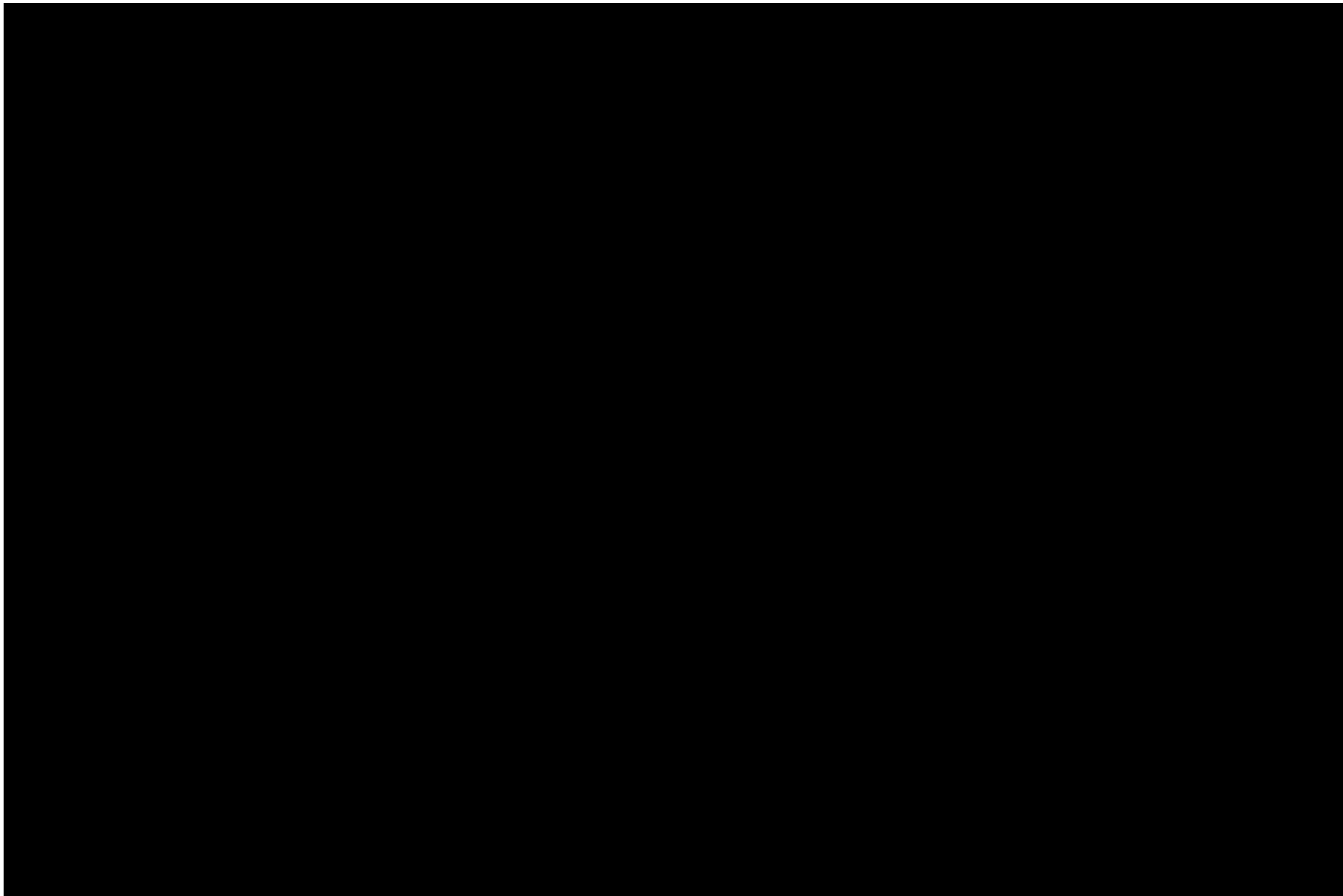
